-A Registered Hand Therapist who is currently non practising -Each member to be approved by Exec Committee -No voting rights

Benefits

-Access to education section and resources on HTNZ website and Fingerprints -HTNZ members conference rates -Streamlined re-entry into Registered membership for first 4 years of Affiliate membership

Maintenance

-Payment of annual subscription fee -Accrue a minimum of 45 points per log book cycle
